## Display Option B

Using different foldables and manila file to create their own stand-up mini-presentation station.

**Square Cube with 4 Panels**

**4 Window Foldable Uses-**

- ❖ Cause & Effect
- ❖ 4 Stages Development Process
- ❖ 4 Phases Process
- ❖ 4 Vocabulary Words

**Materials Needed**

- ✓ Paper (legal works best)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ A Ruler

**Step 1:** Fold paper in HALF the WIDE way and UNFOLD.

**Step 2:** Fold the outside edges into the center to create two flaps as shown in the diagram.

**Step 3:** Measure 2.5 inches from the top and CUT it off to create a square with 2 flaps.

**Step 4:** Fold in HALF and UNFOLD fold line of each of the 2 flaps to the center. Do NOT cut all the way across.
