Square Cube with 4 Panels

4 Window Foldable Uses-

Materials Needed

- ✓ Paper (legal works best)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ A Ruler

Step 1: Fold paper in HALF the WIDE way and UNFOLD.

Step 2: Fold the outside edges into the center to create two flaps as shown in the diagram.

Step 3: Measure 2.5 inches from the top and CUT it off to create a square with 2 flaps.

Step 4: Fold in HALF and UNFOLD fold line of each of the 2 flaps to the center. Do NOT cut all the way across.
