- 3 panel foldable instruction card - **vertical** design
- Student planning worksheet for each foldable in the series with or without special features (ie: tab).

Materials Needed

- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ A Ruler if using the enhanced tab design

Step 1: Fold paper in HALF the long way.

Step 2: Turn the results from step 1 horizontally.

Step 3: Fold the paper into THIRDS (approx 9 cm) the wide way vs. the long way like in Step 1. The dashed line indicates the fold. Unfold to make the paper flat.

Step 4: Unfold the paper to reveal a 3 panel bun style paper. Rotate so that the fold it is on the left.

Step 5: Cut along the folds (dotted lines in diagram) on the TOP half of the paper to the middle fold only. This will create the three panel affect.

Step 6: Turn the folded paper back to a vertical position to create a vertical 3 panel foldable.

Step 2: Pick up at Step 2 on the regular folding process above.

Enhance with a TITLE Tab on the Side

Add Step 1A to create the title tab.

Step 1A: Using a ruler measure off a 2 cm (approx ¾ inch) section from the edge going the tall way. This "line" creates the "edge" you will fold to in Step 1B.

Step 1B: Fold paper in half the long way up to the line you created at the 2 cm mark.

Step 2: Pick up at Step 2 on the regular folding process above.
