Materials Needed

- ✓ Paper (legal works best)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ A Ruler

Step 1: Fold paper in HALF the long way and unfold.

Step 2: Next fold the outer edges into the center fold to create two flaps as pictured.

Step 3: Leaving the flaps folded to the center fold line from Step 1, now fold the paper in HALF. Do NOT unfold.

Step 4: Fold the paper from Step 3 again in HALF.

Step 5: Unfold the paper from Step 4 to reveal and skinny rectangle with 2 flaps with 4 fold line on each.

Step 6: Open up FLAPS on TOP and BOTTOM. These are what you are going to CUT to the TRI FOLD line. Do not cut all the way across.
