Pyramid 3D Standup Foldable

3 Panel Standup Pyramid Uses -

- ❖ 3 Step Process
- ❖ 3 Sides to an issue

Materials Needed

- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ Tape, Stapler or Glue

Step 1: With the paper laying the tall way, fold the upper right hand corner to the opposite side. Met the two edges, to create a triangle with an extra piece at the bottom.

Step 2: Untold and CUT off the extra piece at the bottom to create a perfect square. Toss the extra piece away.

Step 3: Refold paper to create a triangle.

Step 4: Fold step 3 triangle in HALF to create a smaller triangle.

Step 5: Unfold Step 4's smaller triangle and unfold Step 3's original triangle. To create the perfect square of Step 2 but with fold lines criss-crossing the square.

Step 6: CUT along 1 of the folds from the corner to the center of the paper where the folds intersect. Do NOT cut more than 1 fold.

Step 7: Refold criss and slide Tab A on top of Tab B. As you do this a pyramid will rise up from the center.

Step 8: Use a stapler or tape to secure Tab A to Tab B so that the pyramid can stand on it own. You can also glue the Tabs together.
