## Foldable Guides for All Needed Foldables

### Chart - 4 Columns with 2 Top Rows

**4 Column Chart w/ 1 Title Row -**

- ❖ K W L Chart
- ❖ Recording Observations
- ❖ Fact Collections

**Materials Needed**

- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Pen or Marker
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ A Ruler

**Step 1:** Measure a 1 inch twice from the top. Fold the top down 1 inch. Do NOT unfold. Then fold the new top down 1 inch a 2<sup>nd</sup> time.

**Step 2:** Unfold the top fold from Step 1 original paper with 2 fold lines from top edge.

**Step 3:** Fold paper in HALF the WIDE way and do NOT unfold.

**Step 4:** Fold the paper from Step 1 in HALF the long way again.

**Step 5:** UNFOLD the ENTIRE piece of paper to reveal the original piece of paper with 4 columns and 1 top row for titles, words, categories, or groups.

**Step 6:** Use a ruler with a pen to mark the fold lines to create a 4 column table with 1 title block per column.

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### Table Grid ~ 16 Squares

**16 Square Table Uses -**

- ❖ 16 pictures or symbols
- ❖ 8 to 16 step process
- ❖ 16 vocabulary words
- ❖ data table

**Materials Needed**

- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Pen or Marker
- ✓ Coloring Utensils
- ✓ A Ruler

**Step 1:** Fold paper in HALF the long way and do NOT unfold.

**Step 2:** Fold the paper from Step 1 in HALF the long way again. Do NOT unfold.

**Step 3:** Fold the paper from Step 2 in HALF the wide way. Do NOT unfold.

**Step 4:** Fold the paper from Step 2 in HALF the wide way again.

**Step 5:** UNFOLD the ENTIRE piece of paper to reveal the original piece of paper with 16 squares.

**Step 6:** Use a ruler with a pen to mark the fold lines to create a 16 square grid.

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
